**GENERAL PERMIT TO INSTALL PROGRAM
Revisions and Updates**

The AQD may revise or update a general permit to install for various reasons including administrative changes (i.e., addresses, contacts, formatting), clarifying instructions or permit language, or correcting an underlying applicable requirement. These types of minor changes are made without a public comment period because they do not affect the applicability criteria or the special conditions of the general permit.

If a change or revision will affect the applicability criteria or special conditions of the general permit, the MDEQ will hold a public comment period to receive comments on the proposed changes.

If the applicability criteria or special conditions become less stringent as a result of the change (e.g., a setback requirement relaxed from 1000 feet to 500 feet; a reporting requirement reduced from daily to monthly), sources operating under the existing general permit will be notified of the change and allowed to operate under the revised criteria, which can be downloaded from the internet.

A source operating under an existing general permit to install will not be required to meet the new requirements if the applicability criteria or special conditions become more stringent as a result of the change.
