DEQ Postpones Public Hearing of Proposed Consent Order for United States Steel Corporation

The public hearing scheduled for Monday, August 1, 2016, from 6-8 p.m., at the Albert B. Buday Civic Center, 3869 West Jefferson, 2nd Floor, located in Ecorse, Michigan, regarding the proposed Consent Order to administratively resolve alleged air pollution violations at the United States Steel Corporation facility in Ecorse, Michigan, has been postponed. The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division, was informed on Wednesday, July 27, 2016, of a scheduling conflict at the location and has been unable to secure another location nearby. The DEQ will notify the public once a new date is scheduled in September. All previous comments submitted by interested parties will be retained and considered by the decision-maker prior to entering the proposed Consent Order. The date, time, and location of a future public informational session and hearing will be published on the DEQ Environmental Calendar, www.michigan.gov/deqcalendar, and in the local newspaper.
