Computer Recycling @ Constitution Hall Thursday, April 22, 2010 7:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Goodwill will hold a community-wide electronics collection in Downtown Lansing on Earth Day. This is being held in conjunction with the State of Michigan Earth Day event at Constitution Hall. Lansing Area residents can bring in old, unwanted home computer equipment to the Goodwill trailer located near the corner of Allegan and Walnut.

You are responsible for wiping personal data from the computer hard drive prior to recycling. Goodwill will only collect computers and peripheral equipment, so if it isn't a computer or doesn't connect to a computer, Goodwill cannot accept it.

DIRECTIONS: Drive north on Walnut to the designated area on the west side of the street just south of Allegan. Look for the signs and volunteers. Do NOT drive into the Ellis Parking lot for this event.
