








a word about the ReUse Center

DROP OFF ITEMS


The ReUse Center makes it easy and convenient to drop off items. Simply drive through the gates at our S. Industrial location and our staff will assist you and provide you with a tax receipt. Drop off hours are 9-4 Mon-Sat.

RESIDENTIAL PICK UP SERVICE

The ReUse Center provides free material pick-ups for local residents and businesses. A minimum \$75 value for the items is required. Call (734) 662-6288 for details and to arrange a pick-up.

JOB SITE PICK UP SERVICE

Builders and remodelers can call to schedule a pick up of reusable building materials. The center provides a truck and trailer for loading convenience at job sites. See our building materials acceptance list for more details.



What we accept

The ReUse Center accepts the following items in good reusable condition.

BUILDING MATERIAL

Clean Lumber (4' or longer, no rot or infestation, nails are ok)

Doors (good condition, no gray aluminum storm doors)

Windows (no single pane, no aluminum frame)

Chipboard, OSB, Plywood (1/2 sheet or more)

Siding (large lots only)

Flooring (wood and vinyl)

Roofing (no lose roofing, wrapped only)

Kitchen and Bath Cabinets

Kitchen and Bath Sinks (no rust or chips)

Tubs (no chips, cracks or cast iron)

Toilets (white or off-white only)


Tile, Glass, Mirror, Brick, Block, Paving

Lighting and Ceiling Fans (complete, no PCB's)

Hardware and Tools

Fencing (chain link, treated wood no rot)

HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

All household items, including electrical items, must be complete, clean and in good usable condition.

Furniture: couches, desks, tables, chairs, dressers, file cabinets, mattresses, box springs, bed frames, etc.

Appliances:

No older than 5 years old: dishwashers, microwaves


No older than 10 years old: washers, dryers, water heaters, refrigerators, ranges, freezers, small kitchen appliances, dehumidifiers*, air conditioners*

NOTE: There is a \$25 deposit required for accepting Freon filled appliances. The deposit is returned after testing confirms the appliance is in good working order. *Accepted May-September only.

Electronics: stereo equipment, VCRs, color & cable ready TVs, CD players, cameras, telephones, projectors, turntables, computers and monitors**

**Computers and monitors must not exceed 5 years old. All electronics will be screened for age, condition, cleanliness, serviceability and reuse/resale marketability.

We also accept: hardware, tools, lawn mowers, gardening supplies, sport/exercise equipment, books, audio/video tapes, records, CDs, art work, quality kitchenware, office supplies, healthcare equipment, pet supplies, antiques, collectibles and more!



What we don't accept

After hours drop offs are not accepted.

Staff may refuse any item based on condition, saleability and inventory.

We do NOT accept the following:

Condition of Item: anything broken, damaged, mildewed or excessively soiled is not accepted

These Home Goods: clothing, toys, cribs, strollers, car seats, fluorescent bulbs

These Building Materials: shower doors, lumber less than 4' long, nail-fitted/twisted/rotted wood, sheet goods less than 1/2 original size, non-tempered glass storm doors

These Appliances: drum style humidifiers

These Automotive Items: all tires, batteries, engine parts, oil, and fluids

These Furniture Items: steel case desks


These Electronics: black & white TVs, non-cable ready TVs, older computers (see Computer Acceptance Policy), printers and fax machines

All items listed above can be recycled or disposed of at the Recycle Ann Arbor operated Washtenaw County Drop-Off Station located at 2950 East Ellsworth Road in Ann Arbor. Visit our website or call them directly at (734) 971-7400 for a complete list of acceptable materials.

Household Hazardous material can be taken to the Washtenaw County Home Toxic Center. Call (734) 222-3800 for details.

Hazardous Material: flammable liquids, toxic waste, chemicals, paint, used thermostats, used smoke detectors, thermometers
