¹ Broadcast means the legislative director will e-mail all legislative contacts stating the DEQ is awarding some grants, one of which may be in their district; they will attach the press release which will reference the Excel award list posted on the program's Web site.

² Individual legislative contact means that the program will include on their Excel list of awarded projects the representatives and senators. The legislative director will use the Excel list to create an e-mail for each representative/senator, and attach the press release.

³ 2-week notification means that the program manager sends an e-mail to the legislative director, legislative advisor, press secretary and copies the deputy director, letting them know that the program is planning on awarding X number of grants totaling X dollars for the X program on X date (being two weeks from the date of the e-mail). The e-mail is a courtesy heads-up and gives the Executive Division time to determine if a special press release or legislative contact needs to be made. No response from the Executive Division after two weeks means the program can award the grants.

⁴ Copying legislators on award letters will be done by the Brownfield Program, as they award grants one at a time.
