The Federal Bureau of Investigation's, Weapons of Mass Destruction Directorate, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Water Security Division, along with U.S. Department of Agriculture, the Food and Drug Administration, and the Food and Agriculture Protection Training Consortium are co-hosting this Multi-Sector Infrastructure Protection and Threat Workshop.

This no-cost workshop will bring together representatives from federal, state and local officials, law enforcement, industry stakeholders and other partners. The purpose of this workshop is to develop enhanced relationships between all partners in a water, food, and agriculture-related incident. This workshop will educate participants about interdependencies between water, food, and agriculture and other critical infrastructure sectors during a terrorist incident, including weapons of mass destruction, as well as other man-made or natural disasters. Law enforcement officials, water, food, agriculture, and public health officials will build relationships; and discuss roles and responsibilities of various local, state, and federal officials in responding to a multi-sector incident. In addition, participants will identify specific actions participants can take to increase their community's water, food, and agriculture preparedness and resiliency.
