# Brownfield Redevelopment in Michigan

## Program Updates and Improvements Informational Sessions

Brownfield property redevelopment in Michigan revitalizes communities, protects the environment, and creates economic opportunities. Find out how the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is working to drive this program forward.

In cooperation with the Michigan Chapter of the Association of Redevelopment Incentives (formerly the Michigan Chapter of the National Brownfield Association) and the Association of Brownfield Redevelopment Authorities, the DEQ's Remediation and Redevelopment Division is hosting two informational sessions to provide an update on the program improvement process that was initiated in early 2014.

A stakeholder group of public and private entities was convened to consider potential program updates, create recommendations and review draft policies related to the DEQ Brownfield Redevelopment Program. This included potential changes to the DEQ Brownfield Redevelopment grants and loans and the implementation of Act 381 tax increment financing. These half-day sessions will discuss the potential program improvements and final recommendations that will be presented to the DEQ for implementation.
