

Once you or your organization has been issued a permit you can submit required reports or request changes to your permit here.

Finding and Submitting Applications and Requests

Begin by **browsing the available application, service request and report forms**. Once the desired form is located, you can fill it out, submit it, and track it here.

Managing Information for an Existing Facility, Project, or Site

If you are affiliated with an existing facility, project, or site that has had DEQ involvement, your MiWaters account can be granted access to the site in one of the following ways:

- Contact the facility directly and ask the designated MiWaters account administrator to invite you to join the site.
- **Enter a Verification Code** provided by mail from DEQ
- If the site does not currently have an active account manager, contact MiWaters support to learn how to set up a site account.

If your facility, project or site has not yet had DEQ involvement, your site will be created after you **fill out and submit an application or service request** form and DEQ has begun processing it.

About Inviting Users

Invite users to view or edit a site's information. An email will be sent to the address you supply. The email will contain a link for the invitee to activate the invitation. The invitee will be asked to make a MiWaters account if they do not have one already. You may wish to contact the invitee to ensure they look out for the invitation email.

Roles

Roles provide different capabilities:

- Viewer** - May view site information but can't make any changes
- Editor** - May fill out forms and reports. May require certifier permissions to submit, depending on form type
- Administrator** - Can edit site information, invite other users to join the site, inactivate users, and request certifier permissions for users

- Two step process:
- An administrator or editor can request **certifier status**
 - fill out certifier agreement form and submit it
 - and click “request certifier status” button.

Submission of the Notice of Intent (NOI) constitutes notice that the party identified as Owner/Permittee requests authorization to discharge under the NPDES General Permit issued for storm water discharges associated with industrial activity or other activity in Michigan. The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality may deny coverage under the general permit and require submittal of an application form for an individual permit. Becoming a permittee obligates a discharger to comply with the terms and conditions of the General Permit, including annual fee of \$260.00 will be billed each JANUARY. Failure to comply with these provisions may result in fines of up to \$25,000 per day and the possibility of imprisonment, in accordance with Act 451, PA 1994, Part 31.



I certify that my facility has implemented the **non-structural controls** as described in the **SWPPP**. New facilities shall fulfill this requirement when industrial activity begins.

I certify my facility has completed construction and will put into operation all **structural controls** as described in the **SWPPP**. If necessary, new facilities shall fulfill requirement when industrial activity begins.

I certify, under penalty of law, that this document and all attachments were prepared by me, or under my direction or supervision in accordance with a system to assure qualified personnel properly gather and evaluate the information submitted. Based on my inquiry of the person(s) who manage the system, or those persons directly responsible for gathering the information, the information submitted is, to the best of my knowledge and belief, true, accurate, and complete. I am aware there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fine or imprisonment for knowing violations.

I understand that my signature constitutes a legal agreement to comply with the requirements of the appropriate NPDES general Storm Water Permit. I certify under penalty of law that I possess full authority on behalf of the legal owner/permittee to sign and submit this Notice of Intent.
