CITY OF BOYNE CITY, CHARLEVOIX COUNTY, PERMIT APPLICATION 07-15-0002-P. The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality's Water Resources Division is proposing to settle a pending contested case with the city of Boyne City to expand an existing marina, pursuant to Part 301, Inland Lakes and Streams, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, by issuing a permit to replace and expand the existing fixed docks and floating shopper's dock within the existing marina basin. The city of Boyne City has proposed to improve the existing marina. Improvements includes removal of five docks of varying length by three feet wide; replace four of the five docks with permanent fixed adjustable docks measuring 50 feet long by five feet wide; the fifth dock is proposed to attach to the end of the existing sheet pile wall measuring 24 feet long by five feet wide. Additionally, remove and replace 10 wood piles to facilitate safe wharfage. Construction may include the removal and replacement of some rock riprap to facilitate the removal and installation of the proposed docks. Additionally, remove 155 feet of the existing L-shaped shoppers dock (perpendicular to the shoreline) by eight feet wide, with a 55 foot long extension (parallel to the shoreline) by 10 feet wide; replace with an L-shaped shoppers dock measuring a total of 180 feet long (perpendicular to the shoreline) by eight feet with a 55 feet long extension (parallel to the shoreline) by 10 feet wide. DEADLINE FOR PUBLIC COMMENT REGARDING PROPOSED NEW AND MODIFIED GUIDANCE DOCUMENTS FOR ACTIVITIES IN DESIGNATED CRITICAL DUNES. Pursuant to Part 353, Sand Dunes Protection and Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality's Water Resources Division is proposing new and modified guidance documents. One of these documents, "Guidelines for Vegetation Written Assurance" is newly created and describes the Water Resources Division's recommendations for production of vegetation removal assurances. The three other documents are revisions of previously approved guidance documents. The document titled, "Activities Not Constituting a Contour Change or Use" lists activities not constituting a contour change or use within the Critical Dunes. This document is modified to include the addition of two more items that do not require a permit under Part 353. The new language for the replacement utilities under certain conditions has also been added to this revised document. The document titled, "Critical Dune Special Exception" is an update of a previously approved guidance document and outlines the Special Exception review process. The final document is titled, "How to Review a File Under Part 353." The updates were necessary due to statutory changes to Part 353 and organizational changes in the Water Resources Division.
