RECEIPT OF HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATIONS; THE DOW CHEMICAL COMPANY, MICHIGAN OPERATIONS, MIDLAND PLANT AND SALZBURG LANDFILL, MIDLAND, MIDLAND COUNTY. On April 12, 2013, the Office of Waste Management and Radiological Protection (OWMRP) received hazardous waste management facility operating license renewal applications from The Dow Chemical Company (Dow) for its Michigan Operations, Midland Plant and Salzburg Landfill facilities pursuant to Part 111, Hazardous Waste Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended. Dow wishes to continue to operate its hazardous waste container storage, tank storage and treatment, surface impoundment storage and treatment, storage and treatment staging pile/corrective action management unit, and incinerator facilities located at 1790 Building, Midland, Michigan 48674. Dow also wishes to continue to operate its hazardous waste landfill disposal facility located at 2314 West Salzburg Road, Midland, Michigan 48640. The license renewal application for the Salzburg Landfill is being submitted early (during 2013 instead of 2018) in order to sync the renewal processes for the Midland Plant and the Salzburg Landfill for efficiency and to allow some of the license attachments to be combined. The applications are currently under review for completeness and technical adequacy.
