**DEADLINE FOR PUBLIC COMMENT REGARDING SUBMITTAL TO EPA OF MICHIGAN'S PART 3 RULE CHANGES FOR REVISION TO THE STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN (SIP)** The Air Quality Division will hold a public comment period seeking input on revising the SIP to reflect recently promulgated changes to the Air Pollution Control Rules (ORR 2012-136 EQ Part 3), specifically R 336.1310, R 336.1330 and R 336.1349. These revisions include addition of open
