**106 LAURA STREET, LLC, CITY OF LUDINGTON, MASON COUNTY. PERMIT APPLICATION NUMBER: 07-53-0042-P.** The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality’s Water Resources Division (WRD) received modified plans on July 22, 2013, and is proposing to settle a pending contested case by issuing a permit, pursuant to Part 301, Inland Lakes and Streams; and Part 303, Wetlands Protection, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, to 106 Laura Street, LLC. The project site, 106 Laura Street, is located between James and George Street on Pere Marquette Lake, city of Ludington, Mason County. The property owner is proposing a 132 unit condominium development and 89 slip marina on the 5.96 acre Brownfield Redevelopment site, a former industrial facility. The modified plans received by the WRD propose the installation of four fixed floating main piers, having finger piers with boat slips ranging from 30 to 60 feet in length. Additional accommodations for broadside dockage of 23 personal water craft will be limited to the east side of the eastern most main pier. Approximately 2,166 cubic yards of rip rap will be placed along the lakeshore and to a depth of 3.5 feet within Pere Marquette Lake for shoreline stabilization. A 342 foot long 10 foot wide breakwater with a 45 foot long “L” shaped end will be constructed along the western main pier by placement of 793 cubic yards of crushed limestone within two parallel rows of steel sheet piling with a 12-inch concrete cap. The breakwater will be connected to existing city owned sidewalks with a public access easement recorded over the boardwalk. An existing 72- inch city overflow storm sewer discharge pipe will be cut back with replacement of the existing headwall. Excavation of approximately 23,301 cubic yards of material is proposed within the 3.6 acre marina area to a maximum depth of 12 feet below the Ordinary High Water Mark (IGLD 85) with an additional 1,048 cubic yards of material excavated from 0.16 acres of wetland present on the property. Approximately 310 cubic yards of fill is proposed to be placed within 0.05 acres of wetland. All dredged and excavated material is proposed to be removed off-site to a Type II landfill. **PREVENTION OF SIGNIFICANT DETERIORATION (PSD) WORKSHOPS, VARIOUS LOCATIONS, MICHIGAN.** The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division will be hosting workshops to help businesses and consultants understand Michigan’s New Source Review (NSR) regulations and how they affect facilities in the state of Michigan. This workshop will focus on the attainment area NSR regulations known as the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) program. The PSD program affects new, large sources of air emissions and changes at existing large facilities. PSD is a pre-construction air permitting program designed to ensure that the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) are maintained as economic development occurs. This workshop will cover such topics as: PSD applicability, including changes to the PSD program; the technical permitting reviews, including top-down Best Available Control Technology reviews (including greenhouse gases) and air quality modeling; and, the public participation process. This workshop will be beneficial to individuals having environmental responsibilities at facilities that are

major sources of air emissions such as utilities, foundries, auto manufacturers and suppliers, coating operations, and the wood industry. Others who would benefit from attending are environmental consultants and attorneys, environmental groups, trade associations, and interested citizens.
