The Water Resources Division has received a proposal for a wetland mitigation bank in Town 4N, Range 14E, Section 19, Lenox Township, Macomb County. PUBLIC HEARING ON PERMIT APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY TOWER MARINE, ATTENTION R.J. PETERSON, 216 ST. PETER DRIVE, DOUGLAS, MI 49406, MDEQ FILE NUMBER 14-03-0078-P. The Water Resources Division will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, October 22, 2014, at 7:00 p.m., with a question and answer session at 6:30 p.m., at the Saugatuck High School Library Media Center, Saugatuck High School, 401 Elizabeth Street, Saugatuck, Michigan 49453. The applicant proposes to fill approximately 2.16 acres of wetland with 34,000 cubic yards of dredge spoils from Kalamazoo Lake in the process of reconfiguring and expanding a currently existing dredge spoils disposal facility. The applicant proposes 3.24 acres of wetland mitigation, in the form of wetland mitigation bank credits from a wetland mitigation bank within the Kalamazoo River Watershed. The plan for this multi-phase project is as follows:

Phase 1: Excavate spoils from existing impoundment and stockpile these spoils in an upland area along the south boundary of Kalamazoo Ferry Company parcel 03-59-016-036-10.

Phase 2: Continue to place dredge spoils in original impoundment area and in the area excavated during Phase 1.

Phase 3: Regrade the impoundment area to include: regrading and abandoning the east end of the existing containment area, reconfiguring the expanded containment area by excavating dry dredge material to be used to construct new berms to the south of the existing impoundment, and extend the impoundment area onto parcel 03-59-016-036-10, owned by Trustee for St. Peter's Church. The newly reconfigured impoundment will receive additional wet dredge spoils from ongoing dredge activities in Kalamazoo Lake. Total additional capacity for dredge spoils disposal facility will be a total of 85,000 cubic yards.

Phase 4: Use dry dredge material from the south impoundment to fill the north impoundment and create a gentle slope from St. Peter's Church property across to the Kalamazoo Ferry Company property. Once final grading is complete, the site will receive a clean cap, and cover and will be permanently protected from disturbance with a restrictive covenant.
