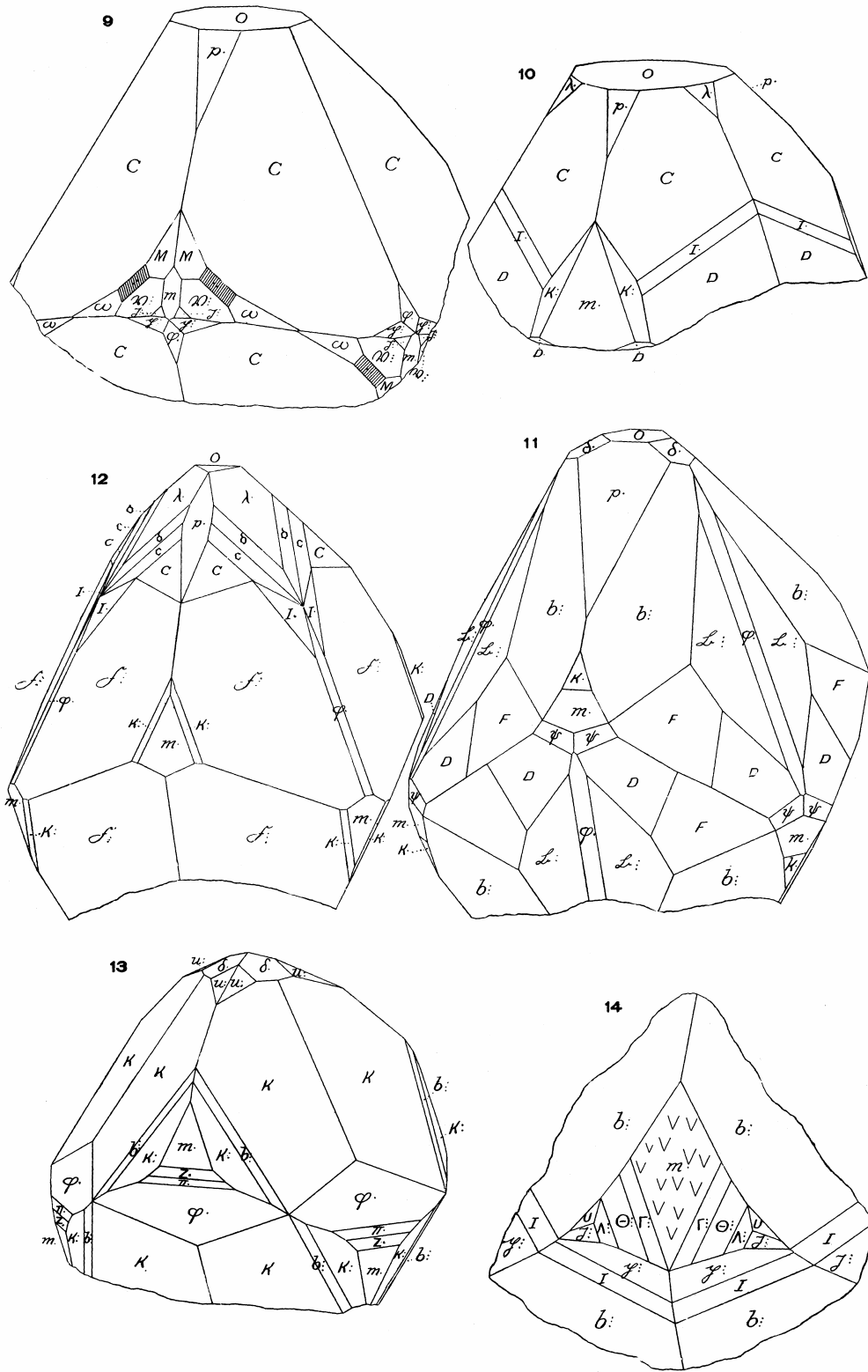
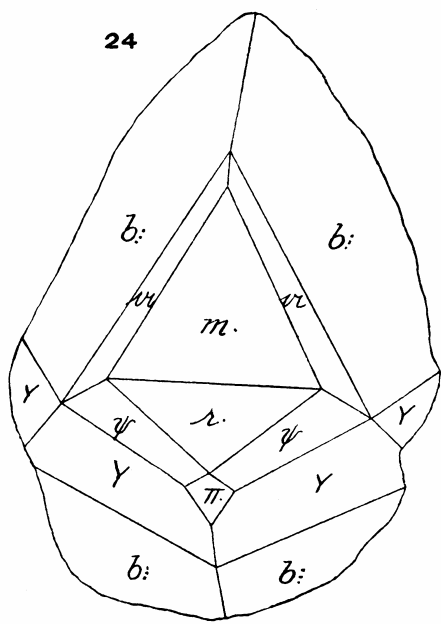
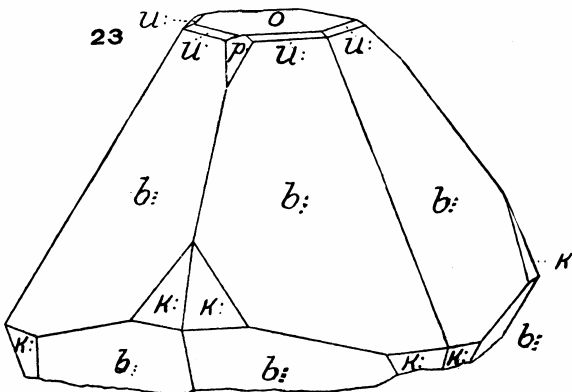
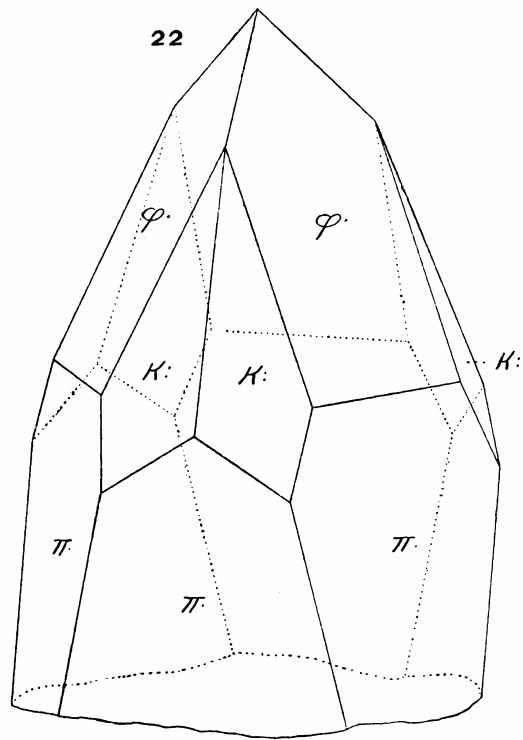
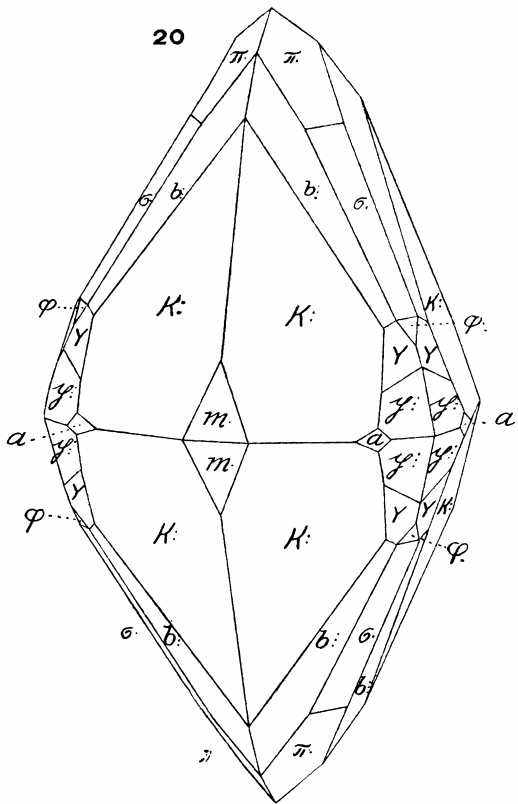


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Explanation of Plates XI to XV

- Figure 1: Bement Collection (171), locality not stated, but similar crystals in the collection came from Owl Creek Vein, Copper Falls Mine, transparent, yellowish, 1 inch high.
- Figure 2: Hubbard Collection (86), Central Mine, colorless, ½ inch high.
- Figure 3: Harvard Cabinet, (33), Minnesota {Minesota} Mine, Ontonagon district, transparent, yellowish, 1 inch high.
- Figure 4: Whiting Collection (9), colorless, ¼ inch high.
- Figure 5: Whiting Collection (3), colorless, minute, the face C which occurs on this crystal, and is referred to twice on page 179, is the face running diagonally down from p.
- Figure 6: Hubbard Collection (268), colorless, 3 inches high.
- Figure 7: Whiting Collection (54), colorless, 1 inch high.

- Figure 9: Brush Collection (127), twin lamella parallel to OP, colorless, 1 ½ inch high.

- Figure 12: Hubbard Collection (258), minute, colorless, etched in part.
- Figure 13: B. F. Chynoweth (259), Ridge Mine, Ontonagon district, yellowish, 1 inch high.
- Figure 14: Whiting Collection (18), water-clear, 2 inches high.
- Figure 15: Harvard Cabinet (30), Central Mine, "Shadow Crystal," with copper inclusions, 1 inch high.
- Figure 16: Hubbard Collection (266), yellowish, 2 ½ inches high, twin on OP.
- Figure 17: Vaux Collection (136), water-clear, 2 ½ inches high (with vertical section), twin lamella parallel to OP shown.
- Figure 18: Hubbard Collection Quincy Mine, twin on -½ R, copper inclusions, 2 inches high.
- Figure 19: Hubbard Collection (75), drawn in orthographic projection, twin on OP, yellowish, 1 inch high.
- Figure 20: BementCollection (164), Owl Creek Vein, Copper Falls Mine, yellowish crystal, 2 inches high, twin on OP.
