**NOTICE OF MEETING**

Take notice that a meeting will be held before the Supervisor of Wells (Supervisor) in the city of Lansing, Michigan, on the FIFTH DAY OF NOVEMBER (NOVEMBER 5) 2015, BEGINNING AT 9:00 A.M., OTTAWA BUILDING, SECOND FLOOR, 611 W. OTTAWA STREET, LANSING, MICHIGAN 48933. The meeting will be conducted pursuant to Part 615, Supervisor of Wells, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (NREPA), MCL 324.61501 *et seq.*; the administrative rules, 1996 AACs, 2001 MR 2, 2002 MR 23, 2015 MR 15, R 324.101 *et seq.*; and the Administrative Procedures Act, 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; MSA 3.560(101) *et seq.*

A meeting has been scheduled pursuant to Order No. 18-2007 and R 324.611. The meeting is for the purpose of receiving information pertaining to the need or desirability of issuing an order in the matter of the petition of Trendwell Energy Corporation (Petitioner). If the proposed action is contested by a party of interest, the meeting will be converted to a hearing, to be held at the same time and place, at which testimony and evidence will be presented.

The Petitioner seeks separate standard production allowables of 200 barrels of oil per day (BOPD) and/or 200 thousand cubic feet of gas per day (MCFGPD) as established in Order No. 18-2007, for the RCI-East 4-19 HD1 and RCI-West 4-19 HD1 wells. The two wells were drilled on a 160-acre drilling unit under R 324.303 and currently have a combined production allowable of 200 BOPD and 200 MCFGPD under Order No. 18-2007. The drilling unit is described as the N 1/2 of NE 1/4 of Section 19, NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 20, and SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section 17, T7S, R6E, Summerfield Township, Monroe County, Michigan.

Take note that if you wish to participate as a party in a hearing in this matter by presenting evidence or cross-examining witnesses, you shall prepare and mail or otherwise deliver to the Petitioner and the Supervisor, not less than five days before the meeting date, an answer to the petition in the manner set forth in R 324.1204(6). Proof of mailing or delivering the answer shall be filed with the Supervisor on or before the date of the meeting. The answer shall state with specificity the interested person's position with regard to the petition. Failure to prepare and serve an answer in a timely manner shall preclude you from presenting evidence or cross-examining witnesses at a hearing. If an answer to the petition is not filed, the Supervisor will enter an order based on his findings at an informal meeting.
