The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Office of Waste Management and Radiological Protection (OWMRP), Hazardous Waste Section (HWS), has reviewed the request for Waste Storage Area I (WSAI) Dike Concrete Replacement received from The Dow Chemical Company (Dow) on March 17, 2016, via email, which requires that a minor modification be made to Dow's hazardous waste management facility operating license, issued September 25, 2015 (License). Based on the HWS's review of the request, the License is hereby modified, as further specified below:

WSAI Dike Concrete Replacement

This minor modification request was submitted pursuant to R 299.9519(5). The DEQ has determined that the minor modification request is substantially equivalent to the minor modification in R 299.9519(5)(a)(iii), Equipment replacement or upgrading with functionally equivalent elements, for example pipes, valves, pumps, conveyors, or *controls*. [emphasis added]


Therefore, the minor modification request is hereby approved.

Required Follow Up

In accordance with R 299.9519(6)(b) of the administrative rules promulgated pursuant to Part 111, Hazardous Waste Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, Dow is required to send notice of minor modifications to all persons on the facility mailing list and to the appropriate units of state and local government. Such notice must be provided within 90 calendar days of this approval. The updated facility mailing list is enclosed. Please notify the OWMRP of any addresses on the facility mailing list that are returned to sender and provide a scan of the returns or the original envelope for our records.
