This is to inform you about activities being undertaken by Pall Life Sciences (PLS) as part of state-approved work plans.

Wagner Road

PLS contractors have started installing a pipeline on the west side of S. Wagner Road, from extraction well TW-18 (about 300 feet south of Porter Street) to the PLS treatment center. This work is expected to continue through the week of December 26. Operation of TW-18 is intended to prevent further easterly migration of contamination in the deep (Unit E) aquifer.

Maple Village Shopping Center

PLS contractors will be performing an aquifer performance test of extraction well TW-19 this week. The test is expected to take one day and will involve pumping the well to determine the effect of extraction on the surrounding monitoring wells. The water will be pumped into a tanker truck and transported to the PLS treatment center on S. Wagner Road. Operation of TW-19 is intended to limit the migration of contamination in the deep aquifer east of Maple Road.
