Only the CSE credits earned by the designated “responsible agent” for a given Michigan licensed septage firm will be credited to that firm. To receive the maximum of 15.5 credit hours a person must attend all sessions on March 25 and 26, then attend the first 2 sessions on March 27, and take the certification program/exam. Without the certification program/exam, the maximum amount of credit hours obtainable is 12.5.
