Course: A one-day class on numerous issues related to the main topics. Some of the items included in the training are: Bloodborne Pathogens - epidemiology and symptoms of bloodborne diseases; modes of transmission of bloodborne pathogens; appropriate actions to take involving blood or other potentially infectious materials; Hazardous Communication – what is a hazardous chemical; how to evaluate your workplace; how to read material safety data sheets; emergency eyewash and shower; Lockout/Tagout training – types of energy; energy control procedures; mobile equipment procedures; periodic inspections.

Credit Hours: The course will count as **6.0 credit hours** toward the continuing septage education (CSE) requirements outlined in Section 11703 of part 117. Only the CSE credits earned by the designated “responsible agent” for a given Michigan licensed septage firm will be credited to that firm.
