Credit Hours: A maximum of **14.5 credit hours** toward the continuing septage education (CSE) requirements outlined in Section 11703 of part 117 may be acquired. Only the CSE credits earned by the designated "responsible agent" for a given Michigan licensed septage firm will be credited to that firm. To receive the maximum of 14.5 credit hours, a person must attend all sessions on November 11 and 12, then attend the first session on November 13, and take the certification program/exam. Without the certification program/exam, the maximum amount of credit hours obtainable is **10.25 CSEs**.
