



Michigan Wellhead Protection Grant Program

Non grant-eligible activities

(Examples are not all inclusive. If you have questions about whether an activity is grant eligible, please contact one of the WHP staff)

Roles and Duties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Food for meetings is not eligible • Mileage/Travel Expenses are not eligible • Employee wages are not eligible for payment unless the employee's specific duties, as outlined in his or her job description, include wellhead protection and have been pre-approved by the DEQ
Delineation Activities and New Wells	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aquifer tests for new wells, as required by the Safe Drinking Water Act, are not eligible.
Management Strategies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purchasing land or real estate is not grant eligible • Sealing abandoned wells is not grant eligible • Activities required by other Federal or State statutes • Water quality monitoring, except Tritium testing
Public participation activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Household hazardous waste collection and other community-wide general groundwater protection activities are not eligible • Equipment purchases are not eligible except for the Groundwater Flow model and other teaching models for WHP
Contingency Plan & Emergency Response Protocol Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Emergency water connections are not eligible even if they are part of the contingency plan, because it is a capital improvement on the water system • Training is not grant eligible
