Mr. Campbell:

On behalf of Butman Township, we have prepared and are submitting a "Septage Receiving Facility Operating Plan" in order for Butman Townships WWSL to accept waste according to Part 117, Septage Waste Servicers, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA, as Amended. This operating plan was developed based on the requirements contained in the MDEQ letter dated February 19, 2008.

Butman Township WWSL would be receiving Domestic Septage from the Sugar Springs Property Owners Association, (SSPOA), Campground and Chalet located in Butman Township. These facilities are used by members and guest from the SSPOA exclusively. No other waste is accepted at this campground, or at the WWSL.

The "Campground" consists of 2 tanks with a combined holding capacity of 3000 gallons. The "Chalet" consists of 2 holding tanks with combined holding capacity of 3000 gallons. The Chalet facilities have 2 restrooms. The Women's has 2 toilets, 2 sinks and 2 showers. The Mensroom has 2 toilets, 2 sinks, 2 showers and 2 urinals. There is also a drinking fountain inside the building.

The SSPOA Building and Grounds would start their hauling in late March or early April until October. The Chalet and campground are open year round and start/stop dates are based on traffic.

Rules for S.S.P.O.A. campground using the receiving lagoon:

Butman Township requires that the SSPOA Septage truck driver sign in at the Wastewater Collection system office before dumping into the receiving lagoon.

SSPOA Septage driver adhere to the proper Personal Protective Equipment necessary to enter the Wastewater Treatment Facilities. A list of this equipment is located at the Wastewater office.

SSPOA Building and Grounds Supervisor shall submit a monthly Septage Volume pump record detailing date/time of dump, gallons, type of Septage and driver signature.

SSPOA must have a current license to remove and transport septic tank waste.

SSPOA shall submit to random sample testing of their loads as requested by Butman Township. Any problems detected by sampling may result in SSPOA losing their ability to dispose of Septage at the facility. SSPOA will absorb the sampling cost if applicable.

SSPOA will submit to random inspections and sampling of their holding tanks located in the campground and chalet. SSPOA will absorb the sampling cost if applicable.

Any operating problems with the receiving area shall be reported immediately to the Operations manager of the Collection system or his designee. A contact list will be supplied to the Septage driver and the SSPOA Superintendent.

Failure to follow these guidelines may result in termination of dumping privileges.
