I think he may have had a heart attack or something. I went right over to check, and he's unconscious. There's a small fire in the engine compartment of his truck and some damage to that wall by where those gas cylinders are. I've called 911.





November 2, 18:00 hrs.

This is Frank Thompson from KWSD with an update on the massive explosion that occurred this afternoon at the Zenith City Water Treatment Plant. We have spoken with the public information officer from the water utility, who reports that the explosion at their facility has resulted in a chlorine leak. The leak has released a plume of chlorine gas into the air, which is spreading over the city. Due to the toxic effects of chlorine gas, injured people are flooding the hospitals, and all citizens are warned not to leave their homes. Any citizen concerned that they may have been exposed to chlorine gas is advised to see their physician. And now, back to you, Chris.

November 3, 17:00 hrs.

This is Frank Thompson from KWSD with a South Zenith resident, Ms. Linda Jones, who is concerned about what the water utility is doing to recover from yesterday's explosion. Ms. Jones, what are your concerns?

"I'm just wondering if the Water Department knows what they're doing. How are they going to recover from this event? How are we sure that our water is okay to drink? Can they even provide us with water? I mean, all the chlorine is gone, right?"
