

## **NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION**

The Dow Chemical Company  
Salzburg Landfill  
Hazardous Waste Management Facility Operating License

The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Waste and Hazardous Materials Division (WHMD), has issued a hazardous waste management facility operating license (License) to The Dow Chemical Company for the Salzburg Landfill pursuant to Part 111, Hazardous Waste Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended. The License was issued on March 18, 2009, and allows Dow to continue to operate a hazardous waste landfill disposal facility at 2314 West Salzburg Road in Midland, Michigan. No U.S. Environmental Protection Agency federal permit was required because there are no federal hazardous waste program provisions that the MDEQ is not authorized for at this time. The Part 111 License will expire ten years from the date of issuance.

The MDEQ conducted a public participation process. Issues raised during that process have been addressed by the MDEQ in the Responsiveness Summary.
