SUBJECT: Delegation Pursuant to Executive Order 1995-18 and Part 111, Hazardous Waste Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as Amended – Licensing of Hazardous Waste Transporters

I hereby delegate all statutory authority, powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities of Part 111, as outlined below, unless circumstances in individual cases warrant a decision at a higher level. The powers and duties are delegated for the purposes of administering the program pursuant to statute and rules.

This delegation includes anyone acting in the capacity of the position named in the delegation below. Any authority or power delegated to a subordinate position may be exercised by a position higher in that position's chain of command on a case-by-case basis, as circumstances warrant.
