- Convey intent and Policy. Set aside some of the history and baggage. Honor the process and the intent.
- 99% there. Make sure we tweak the language (might detract from that).
- Add some intro to get the message across that how this is to be implemented is up for debate.
- Document put together by majority rule. All have some concerns. Rather than sign onto document; just list members in Appendix instead.
- Narrative language is what meeting is to discuss today and not get into policy statements.
- Jim Frey suggests that we add in language into message especially in terms of the legislative process; must look at as a whole.
- Went through document to tweak narrative.
- Message from Solid Waste Policy Advisory Committee in lieu of sign off.
- Transboundary Issue—recognize timeframe in narrative rather than Policy statements. Have to put discussion in somehow.
