**PART 55, AIR POLLUTION CONTROL, NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT, 1994 PA 451, AS AMENDED.** The Air Quality Division will be holding a public hearing on August 11, 2010 (see August 11 listing in this calendar) on proposed revisions to Part 18, Prevention of Significant Deterioration of Air Quality (R 336.2801, R 336.2816, and R 336.2830), and Part 19, New Source Review for Major Sources Impacting Nonattainment Areas (R 336.2901 and R 336.2910), of the Air Pollution Control Rules (SOAHR 2009-055 NE, 2009-056 SR, 2010-022 NE, and 2010-005 SR). The revisions are being proposed to address a deficiency in our Prevention of Significant Deterioration and nonattainment New Source Review permitting rules by adding the new significance threshold for particulate matter less than 2.5 microns in size and to rescind an administrative appeal mechanism that conflicts with statutory provisions. Additionally, we are proposing to revise our Prevention of Significant Deterioration rules to match the federal requirements for Class I areas. ### LAND AND WATER MANAGEMENT DIVISION

**MINIMUM FLOW RELEASE FROM THE GREENWOOD RESERVOIR TO THE MIDDLE BRANCH ESCANABA RIVER REDUCED BECAUSE OF DROUGHT CONDITIONS.** On June 25, 2010, the DNRE's Land and Water Management Division (LWMD) authorized the temporary reduction of the minimum flow release to the Middle Branch Escanaba River. This action is in response to a petition from the Tilden Mining Company. The LWMD concurs that the watershed is experiencing a severe drought, and if weather conditions do not improve, there is a risk that the Greenwood Reservoir could reach critical levels next spring. The required minimum flow release will be reduced from 24 cfs to 16 cfs from June 25, 2010, until September 14, 2010; to 12 cfs from September 15, 2010, until December 15, 2010; and to 20 cfs from December 15, 2010, until December 31, 2010. This authorization is pursuant to the Tilden Mining Company's Amended Order and Permit dated November 2, 1998, issued under the authority of Part 35, Use of Water in Mining Low-Grade Ore, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended. Phenytoin is an anticonvulsant drug that has been used for many years to treat epilepsy and seizures; the criteria were developed as a result of its detection on public property adjacent to a manufacturing facility. The legal basis for the development of the cleanup criteria is [Part 201](#), Environmental Remediation, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, and its [rules](#), specifically R 299.5706a(10). The draft Part 201 criteria for phenytoin and pertinent chemical physical data are available under the What's New section of the [RRD Website](#). After the public comment period, final phenytoin criteria will be included in the Remediation and Redevelopment Division Operational Memorandum No. 1: Part 201 Generic Cleanup Criteria and Part 213 Risk-based Screening Levels Tables. The target detection limit (TDL) for phenytoin is 15 µg/L (ppb) in water and 250 µg/kg (ppb) in soil.
