9. Please describe your takeback program.

Funai and its companies participate in the MRM takeback program for electronics recycling. Under this program, consumers can bring qualified electronic items to MRM-sponsored collection sites across the state and receive recycling for free. MRM contracts with environmentally responsible recyclers to provide recycling services on behalf of the manufacturers participating in the MRM program.

10. What information do you provide to consumers on how and where to return covered electronic devices that are labeled with your name or brand label?

Funai participates in the MRM Electronics Recycling program in Michigan. MRM provides a comprehensive list of all MRM sites on the MRM website – www.mrmrecycling.com. MRM provides the address and a telephone number for each location so that consumers can call the recycling site if they have additional questions. The MRM website provides information on what products and manufacturer brands can be dropped off for free recycling at the sites. In addition, we will be further revising our own websites to include Michigan specific links and information.

In addition, we provide consumers with the MRM toll free number. The number has a recording with location sites and information and consumers can leave a message with additional questions.

11. How do you provide information to consumers on how and where to return covered electronic devices?

Funai and its companies provide information through our own websites and the MRM website and toll free numbers. In addition, MRM provides outreach about its recycling program and locations through press releases and in periodic joint announcement and advertising with collection sites.
