9. Please describe your takeback program.

IBM has chosen The UPS Store®, which in some cases uses participating Mail Boxes Etc.® centers to facilitate our no-charge product take back for our recycling program for Covered Electronic Devices. The UPS Store® and any such participating Mail Boxes Etc.® centers in Michigan beginning April 1, 2010 will accept Covered Electronic Devices for shipment to IBM recyclers. When a Covered Electronic Device has been received by a UPS Store® or participating Mail Boxes Etc.® center, the store or center will package it and ship it to IBM's designated facility for recycling. At this time, this is TCG Recycling, located in Louisville, KY. Consumers do not have to pay a fee at the time of collection or afterward. IBM provides for the collection of Covered Electronic Devices that is reasonably convenient and available to consumers in Michigan, and designed to meet the collection needs of consumers in this state. Consumers may simply go online to the IBM website, print a UPS label or a Mail Boxes, Etc.® label, then bring their Covered Electronic Device to the respective nearest UPS Store® or Mail Boxes, Etc.® center, where the Covered Electronic Device will be collected and shipped for the consumer.

10. What information do you provide to consumers on how and where to return covered electronic devices that are labeled with your name or brand label?

"Several U.S. states require manufacturers to create programs for no-charge product recycling for certain electronic equipment, for example, personal computers, computer monitors and in some states peripherals and related accessories that they have manufactured and sold.

IBM participates in a variety of product take back for recycling programs, including programs in certain states where individuals can ship their IBM logoed computer products and peripherals through The UPS Store® and participating Mail Boxes Etc.® centers (UPS uses some Mail Boxes, Etc.®, centers) to IBM recyclers. We do not charge a fee at the time of collection or afterward for this service. Please use the drop down menu below to determine if IBM or your state has a no-charge product recycling program at this time. Once you have determined that a program is available in your state, please follow the directions to ship your IBM logoed computer products and covered peripherals and accessories for recycling.
