The program covers Lenovo manufactured desktop and notebook computers and computer monitors. Lenovo has partnered with a leading US recycler to offer this program.

The program is publicized on Lenovo's recycling pages at [www.lenovo.com/lenovo/environment/recycling](http://www.lenovo.com/lenovo/environment/recycling). Consumers in Michigan can access the website and enter information about their location and equipment. Based on this information, a shipping label is generated that the consumer can use to ship the used Lenovo product to our chosen partner for recycling free of charge. The consumer merely boxes the product and drops it at the nearest United Parcel Service (UPS) location.

10. What information do you provide to consumers on how and where to return covered electronic devices that are labeled with your name or brand label?

Lenovo's offering provides a FREE recycling solution for any Lenovo product and select IBM products, including system units, monitors, keyboards, and mice. The offering can be accessed at <http://www.lenovo.com/lenovo/environment/usconsumerrecycling>. Equipment from other manufacturers may be recycled as well depending on the age and condition of the equipment being returned. Consumers only have to step through the instructions on the Take Back webpage to see if the equipment qualifies. As part of this service, Lenovo will arrange for free shipping of any Lenovo PC and select IBM PCs via UPS to our chosen recycler. The product has only to be dropped off at the nearest UPS location. This information is communicated via Lenovo's website.
