LG Electronics USA, Inc has contracted with Waste Management Recycle America to act as its collector and recycler of consumer electronics. The two primary means of collection in Michigan are fixed collection sites (see list below) and periodic collection events. Collection events are scheduled only several weeks to a month in advance (not scheduled a year or even several months in advance). LG collects any brand of consumer electronics during collection events free of charge to consumers; fixed sites have historically been available to consumers wishing to drop off (free of charge) LG, Zenith and/or GoldStar brands of unwanted consumer electronics.

10. What information do you provide to consumers on how and where to return covered electronic devices that are labeled with your name or brand label?

See Internet site under "LG Recycling Program"; fixed collection points, addresses and phone numbers are given for each State. A toll free number is also offered.

Internet is primary source of information for fixed site returns. When collection events are held, events are advertised in local media prior to event dates.

Waste Management Recycle America (WMRA) uses mechanical processes to break down unwanted electronic equipment into component materials, which are then sold as commodities for further processing into recycled materials for re-use. WMRA is a signatory of the BAN Recyclers' Pledge of True Stewardship and is currently under audit to both R2 and BAN new recycling requirements. WMRA is under contractual obligation to recycle unwanted consumer electronics in accordance with all State, Federal and Local laws as well as the BAN Pledge requirements. 93 - 98% of product by weight is recycled. Materials are recycled at WMRA sites.
