PURPOSE: Invitation to Attend WaterISAC All-Hazard Consequence Management Plan (CMP) Webinar on March 11, 2010

On Thursday, March 11 at 1:00 PM Eastern Time, WaterISAC will host a webinar on the latest breakthrough in emergency preparedness, response and recovery planning. The document "All-Hazard Consequence Management Planning for the Water Sector," known simply as the All-Hazard CMP, was produced by a work group made up of drinking water and wastewater utilities, water sector associations, and state and federal water programs.

The All-Hazard CMP includes:

- Customizable lists of preparedness, response, and recovery actions that will improve resiliency across all hazards;
- Consequence-specific lists of actions for potential hazards that are most relevant to drinking water and wastewater utilities;
- Example incident-specific flow charts and checklists with links to downloadable and customizable versions online; and
- Information on how the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and the Incident Command System (ICS) are used in preparedness and during response and recovery.

The webinar will be co-hosted by the work group co-chairs, Patty Cleveland, Manager of Operations for Trinity River Authority in Texas, and Brian Pickard of U.S. EPA's Water Security Division. Mike Howe, Executive Director, Texas Section AWWA (and a work group member), will give the presentation on the All-Hazard CMP.
