



Size Does Matter!

When you cut your grass too short the roots die back. Allowing your grass to grow taller (at least 3 inches) will result in deeper roots and a better lawn. Taller grass absorbs more rainwater so less runs off during storms. Less runoff is good for keeping the lake clean.

When you mow the lawn leave the clippings. Your lawn will benefit from this natural fertilizer. Enjoy the lush life for the nicest lawn in your neighborhood, mow high!
