The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality proposes to issue an authorization for a discharge to the ground or groundwater pursuant to Rule 2210(y) of the Part 22 Rules of Part 31, Water Resources Protection, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451) being Sections 324.3101 through 324.3119 of the Compiled Laws of Michigan, and the administrative rules promulgated there under, to:

The applicant, a portable power washer business to wash out the back of refrigerated meat truck trailers, proposes to discharge a maximum 50 gallons (15,600 gallons per year) of washwater with additives only to the ground and groundwater from their discharge areas located in the SE ¼ of the SE ¼, of T01S, R12W of Section 2 of Alamo Township, Kalamazoo County. Wastewater treatment for this discharge is provided by septic tank, gravel filters, with final discharge via a tile field system.

Comments or objections to the proposed authorization received by November 27, 2007, will be considered in the final decision to grant the authorization.
