This certificate of coverage requires Jason Bradford to operate facilities in accordance with the conditions set forth in General Permit MIG019000. The Bradford Dairy Farms, LLC facility is located at 11435 Sparta Avenue, Sparta, Michigan 49345.

References in the general permit to the 'Department' shall be defined as the Grand Rapids District Supervisor of the Water Bureau. The Grand Rapids District Office is located at State Office Building, Sixth Floor, Unit 10, 350 Ottawa N.W., Grand Rapids, Michigan 49503-2341, telephone: 616-356-0500, fax: 616-356-0202.

The magnitude of the 25-year 24-hour storm at the Bradford Dairy Farms, LLC facility is 4.45 inches of rain.

On or before January 1, 2011 all large CAFO waste storage structures at the Bradford Dairy Farms, LLC facility shall be constructed in accordance with NRCS standards, set forth in Conservation Practice Standard No. 313, Waste Storage Facility, dated June, 2003.

On or before July 1, 2008 the permittee shall submit to the Department a copy of the approved Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plan (CNMP) with a copy of the CNMP signature page indicating the Certified CNMP Provider's approval. The CNMP shall contain, but is not limited to, all of the items listed in Part I.A.5.b. of General Permit No. MIG019000.

Any party who is aggrieved by this certificate of coverage may file a sworn petition for a contested case hearing on this certificate of coverage with the Office of Administrative Hearings of the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality in accordance with the provisions of R323.2192(c) of the Michigan Administrative Code. The Department may reject any petition filed more than 60 days after issuance as being untimely.

This certificate of coverage is based on a complete application received by the Department of Environmental Quality on September 6, 2007. The permittee is subject to all conditions specified in General Permit No. MIG019000 issued November 18, 2005, expiring April 1, 2010. This certificate of coverage may be modified, terminated, reissued, or revoked as allowed for in General Permit No. MIG019000. On the effective date of this certificate of coverage, this certificate of coverage shall supersede Permit No. MIG440004, issued August 27, 2003, which is hereby revoked.

This certificate of coverage takes effect on January 1, 2008.
