Dear Ms. DeLong and Mr. DuCharme:

Pursuant to Paragraph 27.1 of the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) *Consent Judgment* signed May 13, 2015 (MDEQ Consent Judgment), and as discussed in meetings with the MDEQ on July 16, 2015 and August 13, 2015, Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership (Enbridge) formally requests to modify Exhibit E – Part 201 Reaches as follows (see attached Exhibit E – Part 201 Reaches Updated October 26, 2015):

- Modify the reach boundary between Reach 4 and 5. County road A Drive will be the new boundary line between Reach 4 and 5. This will create a better break between property boundaries and eliminates a No Further Action (NFA) report with a mixed geographical area with Talmadge Creek or Kalamazoo River property frontage.
- Minor modifications to Reach 9, Reach 12 through and including Reach 18, Reach 22 through and including Reach 24, Reach 47, and Reach 48, were also made to correct for slight adjustments in property boundaries based on legal description and slight adjustments in the thread of the Kalamazoo River where applicable.

In addition, Enbridge formally requests the following modifications to Exhibit G – NFA Report Segment Boundaries of the MDEQ Consent Judgment (see attached Exhibit G – NFA Report Segment Boundaries – Updated October 26, 2015):

- Modify NFA Report Segment 1 to include Reach 2. The submittal date of NFA Report Segment 1 will remain within 365 days after the Effective Date of the MDEQ Consent Judgment.
- Modify NFA Report Segment 3 to only include Reach 3.
- Add a NFA Report Segment that will only include Reach 4. We will use Segment 4 for this report and all of the subsequent Segments will be adjusted accordingly.

Please advise if the MDEQ approves these proposed changes to the MDEQ Consent Judgment and Modifications to Exhibits E and G.

Pursuant to Section 7.4 (c)(ii) which states that *“Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, Enbridge may submit RI Reports or NFA Reports earlier than the date specified in the Annual Schedule.”*, this letter serves as notification that the *No Further Action Report for Reach 3* will be submitted following the approval of the changes to Exhibits E and G.
