

The Michigan Administrative Hearing System has removed this case from its docket, and closed its file in this matter.


The Settlement Agreement is attached hereto, incorporated by reference into this Order, and transmitted to the Director of the Department of Human Services.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

On May 12, 2014, the Bureau of Children and Adult Licensing issued a Notice of Intent to Refuse to Renew the adult foster care small group home known as Peterson Preferred Care. Willard Carter is the Licensee Designee for Carter Care Network, Inc. In settlement of all issues raised in the Notice of Intent to Refuse to Renew, the undersigned parties hereby agree:

- 1) Carter Care Network, Inc. filed an appeal to the Notice of Intent to Refuse to Renew License, but now desires to administratively close the adult foster care small group home license for Peterson Preferred Care, #AS820070443, without further proceedings or factual determinations.
- 2) Carter Care Network, Inc. agrees and understands that the adult foster care small group home license for Peterson Preferred Care will be administratively closed, effective October 17, 2014.
- 3) Carter Care Network, Inc. agrees and understands that it is waiving its right to appeal the Notice of Intent to Refuse to Renew License and that an administrative hearing will not be held in this matter.
- 4) Carter Care Network, Inc. agrees that it will not apply for an adult foster care license under the Adult Foster Care Facility Licensing Act, MCL 400.701 et seq. for a period of four (4) years. Carter Care Network, Inc. and Willard Carter will not be connected directly or indirectly with a licensee during this four-year period. This does not pertain to any adult foster care facilities where Carter Care Network, Inc. is currently the licensee and Willard Carter is the licensee designee.
- 5) This Settlement Agreement is not final until approved by the Director of the Michigan Department of Human Services.




