	<b>Form 377</b>	<b><u>Statement Transferring Physical Custody of Surrendered Newborn</u></b> Form for the adoption agency to transfer physical custody of the surrendered newborn to a prospective adoptive family.	<b>WEBSITE ONLY</b>
<b>Adoption</b>	<b>Pub 823</b>	<b><u>Adopting a Child in Michigan</u></b> Booklet that provides an overview of Michigan's adoption law, describes the types of adoptions available, the role of the court and other helpful information.
