

HOMES FOR THE AGED MEDICATIONS

R 325.1932 Resident Medications

- _____ (1) Medication given, taken, applied per labeling instructions or signed orders by the prescribing licensed health care professional.
- _____ (2) Medications given, taken, applied per resident service plan.
- _____ (3) If supervises resident medications; shall:
- _____ (b) Complete an individual medication log that contains all of the following information:
- (i) The medication.
 - (ii) The dosage.
 - (iii) Label instructions for use.
 - (iv) Time to be administered.
 - (v) The initials of person administered the medication, entered at the time the medication is given.
 - (vi) Resident's refusal to accept prescribed medication or procedures.
- _____ (c) Reason for each administration of as needed medication .
- _____ (d) Evaluate resident's condition if repeated and prolonged use of as needed medication - process included resident's prescribing licensed health care professional, resident's authorized representative, responsible agency.
- _____ (e) Adjust or modify medication with written instructions from a prescribing licensed health care professional who has knowledge of resident's medical needs. Written record of instructions regarding prescription medication.
- _____ (f) Contact licensed health care professional if a resident repeatedly refuses prescribed medication or treatment: follow and record instructions given.
- _____ (g) Contact resident's licensed health care professional if medication error (includes medication not given as prescribed).
- _____ (4) Resident has meds when not in the facility.
- _____ (5) Take reasonable precautions - prescription medication not used by person other than resident for whom medication prescribed.
- _____ (6) Prescription medication no longer required by resident properly disposed of after consultation with health care professional or pharmacist.
