

# BRING YOUR CHILD TO WORK DAY



## IDEAS AND ACTIVITIES

Begin the day with an opening gathering that includes a welcome to guests.

Organize a special staff meeting that day or schedule a meeting where children can attend and take part.

Hold a poverty simulation for children age 10 and older.

Have children create hand-crafted greeting cards for residents at a nursing home. Let the children know who will be receiving their gifts.

Have children create hand-crafted bookmarks to give to foster youth or to a foster home. Let the children know who will be receiving their gifts.

Have children decorate prebaked cookies with decorator frosting and candies. Arrange to have the cookies given to a domestic violence shelter or foster home. Let the children know who will be receiving their gifts.

Arrange a Brown Bag lunch for parents and children to eat together.

Invite a member of your local police force or Michigan State Police to conduct a safety presentation.

Invite a member of your local fire department to conduct a safety presentation.

Conduct an interviewing workshop. Ask adults to interview children and vice versa.
