Dear Ms. Robinson:

On October 9, 2014, the Bureau of Children and Adult Licensing (BCAL) issued a *Special Investigation Report* regarding your child care center license. During this special investigation, Licensing Consultant Cynthia Jalynski found that Kids Play and Stay Developmental Daycare had been evicted from the facility address on September 22, 2014.

Pursuant to the Child Care Organizations Act, a child care license is valid only at the licensed address and cannot be transferred to a separate location. Therefore, the license for Kids Play and Stay Montessori has been administratively closed. Should you apply for a child care license at a separate location, this administrative closure and Ms. Jalynski's *Special Investigation Report* will be assessed at the time of application.

Please note that it is unlawful to provide child care without a license. For more information regarding this misdemeanor offense, you may refer to the Child Care Organizations Act, MCL 722.125(1).
