**ORDER FOR A PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENJOINING DEFENDANTS  
FROM OPERATING AN ADULT FOSTER CARE FACILITY AND  
PROVIDING ADULT FOSTER CARE SERVICES WITHOUT  
A VALID LICENSE**

This matter comes before this Court for a trial on Plaintiff's request for a permanent injunction to permanently enjoin Defendants from operating an unlicensed adult foster care facility in violation of the Adult Foster Care Facility Licensing Act, 1979 PA 218, MCL 400.701 *et seq.* Due to Defendants' failure to

appear at the properly noticed trial and with this Court being satisfied that based upon the pleadings and the previous order granting a preliminary injunction, a permanent injunction should be issued enjoining Defendants from operating or providing adult foster care services at any location within the State without a valid license. Therefore, this Court:

**ORDERS** that Defendants are subject to the requirements of the Adult Foster Care Facility Licensing Act, MCL 400.701, *et seq.*;

**IT FURTHER ORDERS** that Defendants Diane Dupree a/k/a Diane Dupree Staples, Embassy Living Solutions, LLC, Embassy Living Solutions 2, LLC as well as any of Defendants' employees, agents, representatives, assigns, and those acting in concert with Defendants, are permanently enjoined from operating an adult foster care facility and providing adult foster care services at any location within the State of Michigan without a valid license issued by the Michigan Department of Human Services.

**IT FURTHER ORDERS** that Defendants will cooperate with the Michigan Department of Human Services Adult Protective Services workers, Adult Foster Care Licensing workers, and Community Mental Health workers to remove any residents, who may still reside at a home where Defendants are operating or providing adult foster care services and are in need of adult foster care services, as the term is defined by MCL 400.704(6), to a licensed facility. Law enforcement and medical personnel may accompany any of the above mentioned workers, if necessary;

**IT FURTHER ORDERS** that Defendants' continued operation of an unlicensed adult foster care facility could result in criminal charges being brought pursuant to MCL 400.713(1) and 400.713(13).

This is a final order that closes the case.
