FINAL DECISION

The Administrative Law Judge issued a Proposal for Decision (PFD) dated April 30, 2007. Neither party filed exceptions.¹

The factual findings in the PFD are in accordance with the preponderance of the evidence. The PFD is attached and made part of this final decision.

¹ The deadline to file exceptions was May 21, 2007. After this date, Petitioner submitted a letter in which he indicated that he did not intend to challenge the Proposal for Decision. Petitioner also stated that he would like to receive an acknowledgement that once his child support arrearage was below what he described as the "felony level" he could reapply for a license "with a reasonable degree of acceptance." It is not possible to give Petitioner the requested assurance since the final decision in this matter is based on more than Petitioner's conviction for failure to pay his child support obligation.

It is noted that the Petitioner did not file exceptions to the Proposal for Decision. Michigan courts have long recognized that the failure to file exceptions constitutes a waiver of any objections not raised. *Attorney General v. Public Service Comm*, 136 Mich App 52 (1984).

ORDER

Therefore, it is ORDERED that the refusal to issue an insurance producer's license to the Petitioner is upheld.
