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**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL RESIDENTIAL BUILDERS, MAINTENANCE & ALTERATION CONTRACTORS, ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS, FIRE ALARM CONTRACTORS, PLUMBING CONTRACTORS AND MECHANICAL CONTRACTORS RENEWING LICENSES REQUIRED TO PAY CONSTRUCTION LIEN RECOVERY FUND MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL FEES**

Effective **January 3, 2007**, the Construction Lien Act was amended by PA 497 of 2006, which now requires all licensees to pay a permanent assessment of \$10 per year for each license that the license is valid. The \$10 annual fee is to be collected during the license renewal when the license is renewed.

Thus the Residential Builders and Maintenance & Alteration Contractors who will renew every three years will be assessed an additional \$30 membership renewal fee with each renewal application. For those Builders and Contractors whose license expires on May 31, 2009 only will be renewing for a two year period, 5/31/2009 to 5/31/2011, you will be required to pay a total of \$140 (\$120 for 2 year license renewal and \$20 for Fund Membership Renewal) Those renewal applications were mailed in late March. All future renewals issued after May 31, 2011 will be issued for a three year renewal cycle.

The Electrical and Fire Alarm Contractors (12/31/2009), Plumbing Contractors (04/30/2009) and the Mechanical Contractors (08/31/2010) who will renew every three years will be assessed an additional \$30 membership renewal fee with each renewal application. Contractors must submit the total fee with the renewal application in order to receive a new license. ***Please follow the instructions on your renewal application for submitting your payment.***

You must pay the total fee due in order to receive a new license. Please note: The amended Construction Lien Act eliminated any future special assessments of \$50.00, replacing it by a \$10 annual membership renewal fee.
