2009 LICENSURE EXAMINATION CHANGES

HEARING AID SALESPERSON and HEARING AID DEALER

Effective January 15, 2009, the licensure examinations for Hearing Aid Salespersons and Hearing Aid Dealers are restructured as follows:

SALESPERSONS: Consists of two parts:

- Part 1) Written Theory
- Part 2) Practical Ear Impression.

Candidates not previously successful in completing the entire examination must take both examinations.

Ear-Mold Impression practical passing scores obtained prior to JANUARY 15, 2009, are the only examination scores that will carry over to the new examination. Those candidates will be required to successfully complete only the Written Theory examination to fulfill licensure requirements.

The results of any other licensure examinations taken to become licensed as a Hearing Aid Salesperson before January 15, 2009, are now null and void.

DEALERS: Consists only of a Written Theory examination.

The Hard and Soft Ear-Mold practical examinations have been discontinued. If you failed to entirely complete the previously administered Hearing Aid Dealer licensure examination, you must schedule to sit for and take the restructured examination to fulfill licensure requirements.

The results of any licensure examination taken to become licensed as a Hearing Aid Dealer before January 15, 2009, are now null and void.
