Additional information pertaining to a proposal received after the due date and time will not be accepted.”

2. **All applicants who have submitted their proposals before October 22, 2009, at 5:00 pm, may resubmit their proposal before the new deadline of November 5, 2009, at 5:00 pm.**

3. All other terms and conditions remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
