FINAL DECISION

BACKGROUND

This case concerns the application of Albert Chisholm, Jr. (Petitioner) for a resident insurance producer license. Petitioner filed his application with the Office of Financial and Insurance Regulation (OFIR) in 2008. On the application, Petitioner disclosed that he had a child support obligation in arrearage. Based on that fact, the license application was denied pursuant to section 1239(1)(m) of the Michigan Insurance Code, MCL 500.1239(1)(m). Petitioner appealed the denial and requested a hearing.

A hearing was scheduled but the Petitioner informed OFIR that he no longer wanted to receive a license.

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OFIR staff has now requested that a final decision be issued in this matter confirming that
Petitioner will not be granted a license.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ORDERED that the Petitioner's application for an insurance producer
license is denied.
