**EX PARTE ORDER APPROVING JILL HUISKEN'S COMPENSATION AS  
SPECIAL DEPUTY REHABILITATOR**

At a session of said Court  
held in the Circuit Courtrooms  
for the County of Ingham,  
State of Michigan, on the  
19<sup>th</sup> day of Oct, 2010.

PRESENT: HONORABLE WILLIAM E. COLLETTE, CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE

**WHEREAS**, Ken Ross, the Commissioner of the Michigan Office of Financial and  
Insurance Regulation ("OFIR") and duly appointed Rehabilitator of American Community

Mutual Insurance Company (the "Rehabilitator") has filed an Ex Parte Petition for Approval of Jill Huisken's Compensation as Special Deputy Rehabilitator (the "Ex Parte Petition"); and

**WHEREAS**, MCL 500.8114(1) authorizes the Rehabilitator to appoint one or more Special Deputy Rehabilitators as he considers necessary, whose compensation shall be fixed by the Rehabilitator with the approval of the Court; and

**WHEREAS**, MCL 500.8114(1) further provides that any person appointed as a Special Deputy Rehabilitator shall serve at the Rehabilitator's pleasure; and

**WHEREAS**, due to OFIR staffing needs, and pursuant to the Rehabilitator's authority to appoint and/or replace Special Deputy Rehabilitators at his pleasure, the Rehabilitator has appointed Jill Huisken, OFIR Senior Financial Analyst, as a Special Deputy Rehabilitator of American Community to serve in the place of Special Deputy Rehabilitator Michael Hogan.

**WHEREAS**, the Rehabilitator has determined that the appointment of Jill Huisken as a ~~Special Deputy Rehabilitator to replace Michael Hogan is both necessary and appropriate for the~~ effective and efficient administration of this Rehabilitation proceeding and will assist in providing maximum protection to creditors, policyholders, and the public;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Court APPROVES the compensation to be paid to Jill Huisken, as fixed by the Rehabilitator pursuant to the terms set forth in the Ex Parte Petition, in connection with her appointment as a Special Deputy Rehabilitator of American Community.


**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that effective with Ms. Huisken's appointment, Mr. Hogan's appointment as a Special Deputy Rehabilitator of American Community, together with the powers and responsibilities granted to Mr. Hogan in that capacity, are terminated.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that as a Special Deputy Rehabilitator, Ms. Huisken will work under the direction and supervision of Special Deputy Rehabilitator James Gerber. Subject to the supervision and direction of Mr. Gerber, the Rehabilitator, and this Court, Ms. Huisken shall have all the powers and responsibilities of the Rehabilitator granted under MCL 500.8114.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that both Mr. Gerber and Ms. Huisken shall continue to serve at the pleasure of the Rehabilitator, who reserves the right to appoint other Special Deputy Rehabilitator(s) to replace and/or serve with Mr. Gerber and Ms. Huisken in the future as the need arises.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that due to the difficulty and prohibitive cost associated with providing personalized notice of the Ex Parte Petition and this Order to all parties with an interest in this matter, the Court authorizes, approves, and/or ratifies the Rehabilitator's service of the Ex Parte Petition and this Order by posting electronic copies on the OFIR website, ~~[www.michigan.gov/ofir](http://www.michigan.gov/ofir), under the section "Who We Regulate" and the subsection "American~~  
Community." The Court finds that service in this manner is reasonably calculated to give interested parties actual notice of these proceedings and is otherwise reasonable under the circumstances.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**
