**EX PARTE ORDER CONFIRMING TERMINATION OF
JILL HUISKEN'S APPOINTMENT AS SPECIAL DEPUTY REHABILITATOR**

At a session of said Court
held in the Circuit Courtrooms

State of Michigan, on the

PRESENT: HONORABLE WILLIAM E. COLLETTE, CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE

WHEREAS, Ken Ross, the Commissioner of the Michigan Office of Financial and Insurance Regulation ("OFIR") and duly appointed Rehabilitator of American Community Mutual Insurance Company (the "Rehabilitator") has filed an Ex Parte Petition to Confirm

Termination of Jill Huisken's Appointment as Special Deputy Rehabilitator (the "Ex Parte Petition"); and

WHEREAS, MCL 500.8114(1) authorizes the Rehabilitator to appoint one or more Special Deputy Rehabilitators as he considers necessary, whose compensation shall be fixed by the Rehabilitator with the approval of the Court; and

WHEREAS, MCL 500.8114(1) further provides that any person appointed as a Special Deputy Rehabilitator shall serve at the Rehabilitator's pleasure; and

WHEREAS, due to OFIR staffing needs, and pursuant to the Rehabilitator's authority to appoint, terminate, and/or replace Special Deputy Rehabilitators at his pleasure, the Rehabilitator has elected to terminate Jill Huisken's appointment as a Special Deputy Rehabilitator of American Community;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Court confirms the Rehabilitator's termination of Jill Huisken's appointment as a Special Deputy Rehabilitator of American Community effective January 4, 2011.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that effective January 4, 2011, Ms. Huisken's appointment as a Special Deputy Rehabilitator of American Community, together with the powers and responsibilities granted to Ms. Huisken in that capacity, are terminated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that James Gerber will continue to serve as the sole Special Deputy Rehabilitator of American Community at this time, and his authority in that role remains unchanged.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Gerber shall continue to serve at the pleasure of the Rehabilitator, who reserves the right to appoint other Special Deputy Rehabilitator(s) to replace and/or serve with Mr. Gerber in the future as the need arises.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that because no interested party may rightfully object to the Rehabilitator's discretionary termination of Ms. Huisken as a Special Deputy Rehabilitator, and due to the difficulty and prohibitive cost associated with providing personalized notice of the Ex Parte Petition and this Order to all parties with an interest in this matter, the Court authorizes, approves, and/or ratifies the Rehabilitator's service of the Ex Parte Petition and this Order by posting electronic copies on the OFIR website, www.michigan.gov/ofir, under the section "Who We Regulate" and the subsection "American Community." The Court finds that service in this manner is reasonably calculated to give interested parties actual notice of these proceedings and is otherwise reasonable under the circumstances.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
