The bill creates the Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Revolving Loan Fund. The Fund would be administered by the Department of Energy, Labor & Economic Growth. The department would be required to spend money from the fund only to administer and operate a program to provide loans, grants, and other forms of assistance to public or private entities for energy efficiency or renewable energy projects. The program is required to be consistent with Title III of the Energy Policy and Conservation Act (State Energy Program) and other applicable state and federal law. Projects eligible for assistance, the amount of assistance, and other conditions would be determined by the department. Loans would be required to be made pursuant to a loan agreement. The agreement would be required to contain appropriate provisions relating to maturity or length of the loan, repayment terms, state or local funding requirements, and other provisions necessary to comply with state and federal law. The bill is identical to Senate Bill 852.
